## I trusted hubby, Alt says

Actress-model Carol Alt had lots of good things to say about former hockey player Ron Greschner when she testified in federal court yesterday about their 18-year marriage, but the good vibe wasn't enough to end their dispute about money earned in a business venture.

Alt, 47, recalled telling Greschner as they discussed money after separating in 1997: "My career's on the way down. Can you just be fair?"

She said she completely trusted the former Rangers defenseman, who handled her finances until 1999.

Judge Colleen McMahon is expected to announce her verdict today.

Alt, who has appeared on the cover of Sports Illustrated's swimsuit issue and on TV shows including "King of the Hill" and "The Apprentice," sued Greschner for \$1 million after seeing him in 2007 at a Rangers game and inquiring about their joint investment in a water filtration business.

The business had been sold 10 years earlier, though Greschner, 53, said he did not owe Alt money
