

# Alt out \$1M and court costs

**SUPERMODEL CAROL ALT** will have to use her Playboy money to pay ex-husband Ron Greschner's lawyers.

Alt lost her courtroom clash with Greschner yesterday and then delivered a rambling, tearful speech in which she professed her undying love for the former Rangers defenseman who was her husband for 18 years.

"Ronnie is and shall remain close to my heart," Alt said. "I trusted Ronnie, my friend, my lover, my confidant."

Greschner, 53, said his ex sued because she "harbors resentment" toward him. He's remarried and lives in West Palm Beach, Fla., with his wife and five children.

"Carol's a good person," Greschner told the

Daily News. "A lot of people put things in her mind."

Manhattan Federal Judge Colleen McMahon told Alt, 47, she waited too long to make a claim for nearly \$1 million she says Greschner owes her from the 1997 sale of stock in a Canadian water company.

"It was up to her to protect her interest," McMahon said. "When one is entered into a separation agreement, one should not be trying to be a nice person."

Alt, who will appear in the December edition of Playboy, said she trusted Greschner and wouldn't have handed it any differently.

"Call me a dumb brunette, instead of a blond," she said.
